Crucified Ministries has formed a group called F1 Engineering in response to the recent earthquake in Haiti and other natural disasters around the world. The primary goal of F1 engineering is to assist in the development of infrastructure through offering engineering support to third world missionaries, and training indigenous workers in good building practices.

Already F1 has assisted Missions International of America in a solar power installation during early March, and will be working with MIA again in June. However, this letter is primarily for our April project, in partnership with the Hands and Feet Project and Mission of Hope Haiti, located in Grand Goave, near the epicenter of the earthquake.

The Plan:

F1 has assembled a team, including 3 electrical engineers, to travel to the Grand Goave orphanage run by Mission of Hope Haiti in April to install a solar power station and evaluate other needs. This will be a week long trip, with an end goal of providing continuous power to run water pumps and filtration, lights for during the nighttime, and fans to keep temperatures bearable. Also, this power would be used to aid reconstruction efforts with power tools, offering a substantial increase in productivity.

The team will be lead by Travis Knipple, who was the lead installation engineer at the MIA solar project in Les Cayes and has designed the system for Grand Goave himself. We will also be assisted by 3 or 4 Haitians that work closely with MIA. They will travel with us from Les Cayes to serve as interpreters, electricians (2 of them have training), and general laborers.

How you can help:

First, pray. Please lift the many aspects of this project up in your prayers, but even more importantly, pray for the Haitians themselves. This tragedy is also an opportunity for Christ's love and compassion to be shown to people with a very mixed religious background, including strong voodoo traditions. If all of our projects fail, but one single person accepts Christ, our mission will still be successful.

Second, if you are willing and able to go on a trip like this, email me at travis@crucifiedministries.com and I will keep you on the list for projects as the need arises. If you have a specific skill, please let me know. This includes medical training (EMT, Nurses, etc) and technical skill (professional level in construction, electrician work, engineering, etc). If you don't have this type of background, still contact me and I will work to get you involved. Please do not undervalue yourself, you can be an important part of this relief effort.

Third, financial aid is needed. Our current budgetary needs for this trip are \$10,000 for materials, shipping, and transportation costs. The only reason we do not have a fixed date for the project is the lack of financial support for purchase the materials. The sooner we raise the money, the sooner we go to Haiti.
